12/31 Financial Highlights

Praise the Lord for His provision of financial resources at year-end! We ended up with a small surplus for 2011. During 2011, actual general fund contributions were \$55,730 less than budgeted general fund contributions. Actual total expenses were \$58,725 less than budgeted total expenses, and actual net income was \$3,971 more than the budgeted net income. Here are the details:
