Esaie and Natacha Etienne, Living Stone Reformed Ministry (LSRM), Haiti Esaie earned his Master of Divinity degree from Reformed Theological Seminary (RTS) Orlando. He is an ordained minister of the PCA in the Southwest Florida Presbytery. LSRM is involved in church planting, leadership training and mercy ministry. They own and operate a school for children, a medical mission, and a children's home. Pray that the ministry will receive the resources necessary to effectively carry out its mission and operational goals, doing so even in the midst of Haiti's 29% increase in inflation. Pray for Esaie's safety as he travels back and forth to Haiti and labors in what has become an increasingly challenging, and potentially dangerous environment.
