Leader: What does the sixth petition mean?

And so, Lord, uphold us and make us strong by the power of your Holy Spirit, so that we may not be defeated in this spiritual fight, but may firmly resist our enemies until we finally win the complete victory.*

Leader: How do you conclude this prayer?

Leader and People: *"For yours is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever." This means we have made all these petitions of*

you because, as our all-powerful king, you are both willing and able to give us all that is good; and because your holy name, and not we ourselves, should receive all the praise, forever.
