CHILDREN'S MINISTRY UPDATES: We are so thankful to the LORD to be able to re-start most of our regular ministries at POPC. During this re-start, we have had the opportunity to evaluate how we are doing in all of our ministry plans and have decided to make a few logistical changes that impacts you and your children. There will no longer be ChurchTime offered for the 4-year-old class, which means they will stay in worship for the entire service. This is more consistent with their inclusion in Cherub Choir on Sunday nights and Wednesday night Catechism.
