CHILDREN'S MINISTRY UPDATES: We are so thankful to the LORD to be able to re-start most of our regular ministries at POPC. During this re-start, we have had the opportunity to evaluate how we are doing in all of our ministry plans and have decided to make a few logistical changes that impacts you and your children. There will no longer be ChurchTime offered for the 4-year-old class, which means they will stay in worship for the entire service. This is more consistent with their inclusion in Cherub Choir on Sunday nights and Wednesday night Catechism. Our 2 and 3-year-old Church Time will be moving to the nursery building, for better security and safety. Parents will need to drop them off there when we dismiss from the morning worship service. For those in the 8:30 service, parents will need to pick up their children from the nursery building and take them to their Sunday School class. Our 3-year-old Kingdom Kids which takes place on Sunday nights will also move to a room in the nursery building. When children are dismissed from evening worship, the 3-year-olds will go to the nursery building.
