The words of this anthem were written in honor of missionaries John and Betty Stam, who were martyred for their faith in China in 1934. Their 3-month-old daughter, Helen, was hidden in a sleeping bag during the 12-mile march to their deaths. Miraculously, Helen was discovered days later still alive. Upon receiving news of their deaths, Frank Houghton penned this hymn which was inspired by II Corinthians 8:9 "For you know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that though He was rich, yet for your sake He became poor, so that you by his poverty might become rich." John and Betty Stam were compelled to live and die by the truth that was later printed on John's tombstone: "That Christ may be glorified whether by life or by death. For me to live is Christ and to die is gain." Philippians 1:20-21
