The Confession of Faith Westminster Larger Catechism #24-26

Leader: What is sin?

Leader and People: Sin is any want of conformity unto, or transgression of, any law of God, given as a rule to the reasonable creature.

Leader: Wherein consists the sinfulness of that estate whereinto man fell?

Leader and People: The sinfulness of that estate whereinto man fell, consists in the guilt of Adam's first sin, the want of that righteousness wherein he was created, and the corruption of his nature, whereby he is utterly indisposed, disabled, and made opposite unto all that is spiritually good, and wholly inclined to all evil, and that continually; which is commonly called original sin, and from which do proceed all actual transgressions.

Leader: How is original sin conveyed from our first parents unto their posterity?

Leader and People: Original sin is conveyed from our first parents unto their posterity by natural generation, so as all that proceed from them in that way are conceived and born in sin.
