Manuel "Tito" and Kim Padilla, Equipping Leaders International (ELI)

Tito, an ELI instructor, and Kim are leveraging their nearly 30 years of cross-cultural ministry to teach and disciple Latino pastors in the grace and truth of the gospel. Tito asks us to pray that God would bless their final weeks of teaching *Bible Survey* to a group of about 60 pastors/leaders in Argentina. He also asks us to pray that the Holy Spirit would make fruitful the teaching from 1st Timothy that they were able to present (Jan.18-26) in the Dominican Republic to a group of 130 pastors/leaders, and that the Lord would enable those leaders to teach 1st Timothy to other indigenous leaders.
