The Confession of Faith Westminster Larger Catechism #163-164

Leader: What are the parts of a sacrament?

*Leader and People: The parts of a sacrament are two; the one an outward and sensible sign, used according to Christ's own appointment; the other an inward and spiritual grace thereby signified.*
