Esaïe and Natacha Etienne are natives of Haiti who have lived in South Florida for over 30 years. They have 3 sons, Ishtyler, Isaiah and Ishmaiah, a grandson, Emmaus, and a granddaughter, Sariyah Natacha. Esaïe is a graduate of Reformed Theological Seminary with a Master of Divinity. Natacha has a master's degree in social work at Florida Atlantic University. They have worked in Haiti as MTW missionaries since 2006. Their ministry includes church planting, leadership training, and mercy ministry. In conjunction with MTW, they are now waiting for residency documents to move to the Dominican Republic at the end of January 2024 to lead and oversee ministries in both the Dominican Republic and in Haiti.



Carl Kalberkamp was born in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania. He has been at Pear Orchard Presbyterian Church since 1994. He was a campus staff minister with the Coalition for Christian Outreach from 1979-1982. He attended Westminster Seminary from 1982-1987. Sam Bolen is the executive director of Jackson Leadership Foundation, a ministry formed as an answer to the question, "Is there a way to empower Christians to spiritually and physically transform Jackson's under-resourced communities?"

Stan Buckley is the founder and Executive Director of But God Ministries, an organization that shares the love of Jesus Christ through building sustainable communities around the world.

Michelle Maly serves with Lifesong for Orphans. Michelle is originally from Omaha, attended Belhaven in Jackson, and has served in Odessa, Ukraine, since 2002. She and her Ukrainian teammates minister to orphans living in government orphanages and trade schools. Michelle also helps to run transition and foster homes where children and teenagers live in families with Christian house parents as they grow and then transition to adult life. When the war began, Michelle, some teammates, and some orphans evacuated out of Ukraine. Michelle continues to lead and help organize the team as they provide humanitarian aid and supplies to those in need, stay in contact with orphan graduates and evacuated kids, and support the families of kids who attended the orphanage school before the war.
