## Fall Retreat

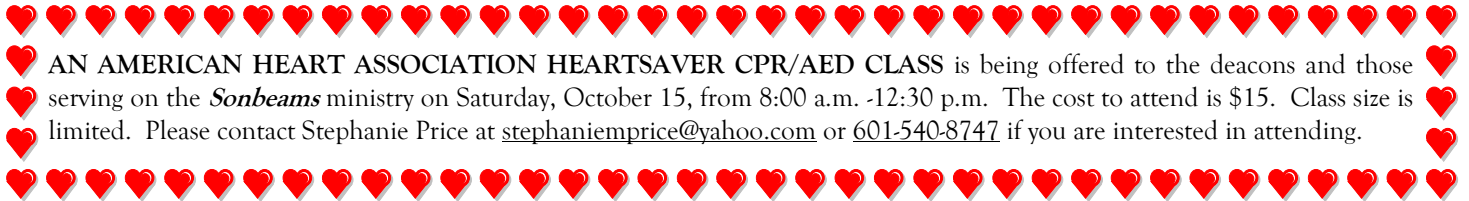
